FURTHER ORDERED: Directing the clerk of the superior court to transmit to this court a certified copy of the superior court's determination regarding appellant's waiver of appellate counsel within 5 days after its entry, marked for filing in this appeal. FURTHER ORDERED: That the stay will be automatically lifted on 08/27/2024, unless one of the parties or the superior court seeks to extend the stay.
