FURTHER ORDERED: The stay will lift automatically on 10/10/2024. FURTHER ORDERED: Vacating the 08/15/2024, order directing appellant to make financial arrangements for the preparation of the transcripts and to file a notice in this court as to the arrangements made. The court will enter another order once the stay is lifted that directs appellant to make financial arrangements for the transcripts if appellant does not file a request to proceed as indigent in the superior court or if the superior court denies appellant's request to proceed as indigent.
