9. 27-Mar-2026 ORDERED: staying this appeal until 4/29/26. FURTHER ORDERED: revesting jurisdiction in the Maricopa County Superior Court and authorizing that court to consider a motion for signed judgment with Rule 78(c) language corresponding to the minute entry dated 12/22/25 and filed 12/23/25. FURTHER ORDERED: appellant must file a motion asking the superior court to enter a signed judgment with Rule 78(c) language. FURTHER ORDERED: if the superior court has not entered a signed judgment by 4/29/26 appellant must file a motion to continue the stay of this appeal. Otherwise, this court will dismiss this appeal.
