FURTHER ORDERED: Appellant must file a motion asking the superior court to enter a signed Rule 78(b) order. FURTHER ORDERED: If the superior court has not entered a signed Rule 78(b) order by 04/14/2026 [sic], appellant must file a motion to continue the stay of this appeal that describes the status of the matter. Otherwise, this court will dismiss this appeal. FURTHER ORDERED: Directing the Clerk of the Yavapai County Superior Court to transmit a certified copy of the ruling within 10 days after its entry, marked for filing in this appeal. The stay will be lifted automatically when this court receives the signed Rule 78(b) order. FURTHER ORDERED: The case management statement is due by 08/17/2026, and the opening brief is due by 09/08/2026. If the statement and brief are not timely filed, the court will dismiss this appeal.
