- 12-Aug-2024 On April 23, 2024, Petitioner Isaac King filed a Petition for Review of Denial of Special Action Relief. In this filing, Petitioner advised, "The defense has not filed any notice suggesting a defense of guilty except insane," and "A.R.S. § 13-4508 (and Ariz. R. Crim. P. Rule 11.7) both establish that reports issued pursuant to Chapter 41 are privileged and confidential, and cannot be used for any purpose except in guilty except insane proceedings, court-ordered treatment proceedings, sexually violent person proceedings, and competency proceedings, none of which are ongoing in King's case."

The Court notes that the trial court entered an order on July 31, 2024, pertaining to these proceedings that refers to a guilty except insane defense. The Court is disinclined to enter an advisory opinion in a pending criminal matter.
