- 26-Aug-2024 On June 24, 2024, the Court of Appeals issued an Order Accepting Special Action Jurisdiction but Denying Relief. On July 9, 2024, Petitioner Lechner filed "Petitioner's Motion for Statement of Reasons Concerning Denial of Special Action," which the Court treated as a Motion for Reconsideration and denied on July 10, 2024.

On August 25, 2024, Petitioner filed a "Petition for Review of a Special Action Decision of the Court of Appeals" that does not comply with Criminal Rule 31.21 (b)(2)(A), Ariz. R. Crim. P., requiring a petition to be filed "no later than 30 days after the Court of Appeals enters its decision or no later than 15 days after the disposition of a timely filed motion for reconsideration." The Petition also does not comply with Rule 31.21(g), saying that a petition "must not exceed 3,500 words." After consideration,

IT IS ORDERED dismissing the petition for review as untimely and non-compliant. (Hon William G Montgomery)
