The petition and motions request that the Court review the superior court's May 11, 2026, findings and order "that the State shall pay a sanction in the amount of \$500.00."

Upon consideration, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Petitioner's Motion for Procedural Order: Motion for Leave to File Late Petition is granted and Petitioner's Petition for Review is accepted for filing as of July 8, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner's Motion for Stay of enforcement of the superior court's May 11, 2026 order awarding monetary sanctions is granted pending further order of this Court. This stay shall not impair the continuation of trial proceedings in this matter.
