8. 6-May-2026 ORDERED: Petition for Review = GRANTED as to the following rephrased issues:
1. In a civil case, during voir dire, may a trial court rehabilitate a prospective juror challenged for bias, prejudice, or loyalty to a party solely by asking whether the juror can be fair and impartial?
 2. Is the appearance of the denial of the right to an impartial jury as a result of seating a biased juror sufficient to require a new trial without a showing of prejudice?
 3. In a civil trial, can a party question jurors about a fellow juror's favorable personal comments about a party?
- FURTHER ORDERED: The case shall be set for oral argument.
- FURTHER ORDERED: The parties may file simultaneous supplemental briefs, not to exceed 20 pages in length, no later than May 26, 2026. Any amicus briefs are due on or before June 5, 2026 and any responses to amicus briefs are due on or before June 15, 2026. Any amicus briefs or responses may not exceed 20 pages in length.
