5. 1-Jun-2026 On April 26, 2026, Petitioner Walls-Bey, pro se, filed a "Petition for Special Action with Request for Emergency Interlocutory Stay" ("Petition") challenging the superior court's April 8, 2026 order denying "Defendant's Notice of Defective Record and Objection to Clerk's Certification; Motion for Judicial Investigation of Systemic Database Corruption," filed March 8, 2026 ("Motion"). The Petition references the Court of Appeals case numbers 1 CA-CR 26-0024 and 1 CA-CR 26-0123. These matters are both pending in the Court of Appeals. Upon resolution, an aggrieved party may seek review of a decision of the Court of Appeals by filing a petition for review in this Court. See Ariz. R. Crim. P. 33.16(l) and 31.21.

"An appellate special action requests review of an earlier decision of a lower court. A party seeks appellate special action relief by filing a petition. With few exceptions, jurisdiction is discretionary in appellate special actions and may be accepted only if the remedy by appeal is not equally plain, speedy, and adequate." Ariz. R.P. Spec. Act. 2(b)(2); see also Parts I and III, Arizona Rules of Procedure for Special Actions. However, "[i]f a special action is filed in the Court of Appeals or Supreme Court and the action might have been properly initiated in a lower court, the petition must state the reasons for not filing it in the lower court. If the appellate court finds these reasons insufficient, it will dismiss the petition without prejudice." Ariz. R.P. Spec. Act. 11(c). Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED dismissing the Petition without prejudice to Petitioner seeking relief in a lower court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED denying Petitioner's request for stay. (Hon. Kathryn H. King)
