IT IS ORDERED granting an extension of time to file the petition for review to no later than July 6, 2026. No further extensions of time will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. This matter is subject to dismissal if the petition for review is not filed by July 6, 2026. (Aaron C. Nash, Clerk)
- 19-Jun-2026 The record provided by the Court of Appeals reflects a court order finding Appellant Fimbres, Pro Se eligible for a waiver of fees. Under Arizona Revised Statutes § 12-302(I), notice is hereby provided that the fee waiver in 2 CA-CV 26-0135 for Appellant Fimbres has been continued in CV-26-0187-PR.

Appellant Fimbres is required to report any change in financial circumstances to the Court by filing a document describing the change.

At the conclusion of the case, the court may waive fees, order the party to pay fees, or order the party to provide an updated application. (Aaron C. Nash, Clerk)
- 6-Jul-2026 FILED: Motion for Procedural Order for Extension of Time to File Petition for Review (Appellant Fimbres, Pro Se)
- 7-Jul-2026 This matter arises from a decision order in the Court of Appeals that was filed May 19, 2026. The Petition for Review was due June 18, 2026. On that day, Appellant Fimbres, pro se, filed a "Motion for Procedural Order for Extension of Time to File a Petition for Review," and on June 19, 2026, this Court granted an extension to July 6, 2026, warning "No further extensions of time will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances." On July 6, 2026 – for the second time on the date of the court-imposed deadline – Appellant filed a second "Motion for Procedural Order for Extension of Time to File Petition for Review," explaining only that "paperwork from financial institutions take 4-6 weeks to arrive" and "Have to subpoena Cecilia's work for days off list." In the second motion, Appellant does not assert any extraordinary circumstances that have prevented Appellant from filing a timely Petition for Review. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED denying the request for a 30-day extension. The Petition for Review is due by no later than July 21, 2026. No further extensions will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. (Aaron C. Nash, Clerk)
