3.	24-Jun-2026	A Petition for Review was filed with the Supreme Court on June 23, 2026, and the case has been assigned the above number. The Petitioner, an inmate involved in a civil proceeding, is required to pay actual court costs in the manner set forth in A.R.S. Section 12-302(E) (copy attached). The filing fee for this Special Action (or Petition for Review) is \$330.00, as set forth in A.R.S. Section 12-119.01. By means of this order, a first time payment of \$66.00 (twenty percent) is assessed, the balance to be paid in accordance with A.R.S. Section 12-302(E). (Aaron C. Nash, Clerk)

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4. 2-Jul-2026 Petitioner Tripati, Pro Se filed a Petition for Review and Motion to File Petition for Review, postmarked June 19, 2026 and docketed June 23, 2026.
- The Court of Appeals Docket reveals that Petitioner filed his Petition for Special Action For Violation of the Mandate in that court with his return address including his name, ADCRR number, and return address of "P.O. Box 24403, Tucson, Arizona 85734." Three days later—on April 30, 2026—the court entered its Order Accepting Special Action Jurisdiction and Denying Relief. Any petition for review was therefore due no later than June 1, 2026. See Ariz. R.P. Spec. Act. 20(d).
- The Court of Appeals' docket also reflects that the distribution to Petitioner was returned by the U.S. Postal Service as undelivered. Petitioner's May 27, 2026 letter (dated May 21, 2026) to the Court of Appeals requesting information also reflected the "P.O. Box 24403, Tucson, Arizona 85734" address.
- On June 15, 2026 (postmarked June 10, 2026), Petitioner submitted a document notifying the Court of Appeals that his "new legal mail address," was "102081 Rincon Unit 801 E. Jefferson St, Phoenix AZ 85034."
- The Petition for Review and Motion to File Petition for Review reflect an address of "Rincon 801 East Jefferson Phoenix, AZ 85034," which includes a ADCRR email with directions to use 801 E Jefferson Street Phoenix AZ 85034 "[e]ffective July 13, 2026."
- In light of the recent changes to ADCRR's instructions for delivery by mail, and the fact that Petitioner did not have actual notice of the April 30, 2026 order,
- IT IS ORDERED granting the Motion to File Petition for Review. The June 23, 2026 Petition for Review is deemed timely filed and will be considered in due course. (Hon William G. Montgomery)
